The Georgia Baptist Convention has notified me that Antioch Baptist Church has been recognized as the 13th fastest growing Sunday School in small churches throughout our state again in 2010. According to the notification that I received the Church has held this ranking since 2007. Limestone BC has been identified as the church with the highest number of baptisms in 2010. Faith BC has been indentified as the church with the leading ratio of baptisms per resident member in 2010. First Baptist Church, Cochran has been indentified as the leading Cooperative Program contributor, the leading per resident member contributor, and the largest percentage contributor. These churches will be recognized and given certificates at the August Executive Committee Meeting.

Plans are currently being developed to complete major renovations on the HOPE building this July.
